Pastor's Column

“Spiritual Arithmetic” of 2019

Some people love numbers and statistics, and some people have no interest in them. For the church, they are important—we need a budget, after all—but they also aren't the only way of measuring success or failure in ministry. Remember—Jesus changed the world with a congregation the size of ... 12 people.

In January of each year, the ELCA asks every church to organize data around attendance, giving, baptisms, deaths, confirmations, new member additions, etc. (PS—this is a great time of year to write Donna and Tanya and the 2019 treasurers a thank you note for the great work they do!). We organize the data, and submit it along with some other narrative storytelling about the past year.

Maybe after doing this for 20 years, I won't be as excited for the process. But as a young pastor, I sort of love filling out these forms, because it gives me a chance to reflect on the faith formation we've all been a part of in the past 12 months.

This year, our worship attendance average was higher than last year at both churches—14% growth at St James, 19% growth at St. Paul. Are these numbers inflated by a 2018 transition year? Certainly. But are we trending in the right direction? You bet.

Here's the thing though—numbers are just numbers. What I care about is seeing faith come alive in these churches. I care about children getting excited when they learn about “Jesus bread.” I care about adults singing a lyric from a favorite hymn to themselves 4 days later while they walk down a hallway at work. I care about confirmation students actually being surprised and interested by a wild story in scripture. I care about families feeling loved by a community after a funeral. I care about relationships growing based on seeing each other more consistently on Sundays.

I care about you—you who give up not getting out of your pajamas on a Sunday morning, and instead show up to be challenged and delighted and fed in the midst of 40-100 other sisters and brothers in Christ. Thank you for showing up.

“Sooooo.....what exactly does Bread Partners of Washington County do?”

In 2019, St. James dreamed big with a goal of gathering 150 items each month for Bread Partners. We accomplished that goal 10 out of 12 months. This year, St. Paul has set a 2020 goal of collecting 50 items each month for Bread Partners. With all these goals, I’ve been asked a few times, “What does Bread Partners do with our donations?”

Here’s some information:

- Bread Partners gives away food 2x/week
- Every Monday, they send travel teams to rural homes (especially along Hwy 105) to deliver food
 - Every Tuesday, they host a pop-up food bank at the fairgrounds
- Every 2 weeks, they also deliver food to certain homebound residents of Brenham

a little after 6pm

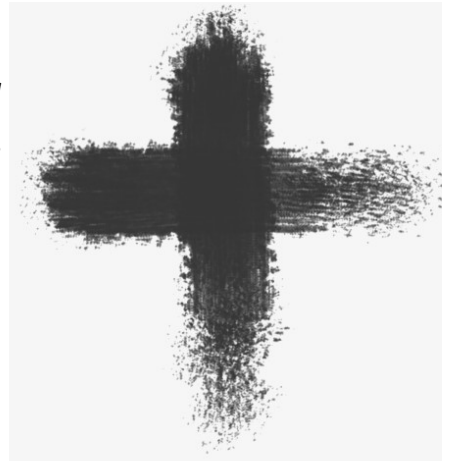
Regular Wednesdays in Lent (3/5, 3/12, 3/19, 4/1)

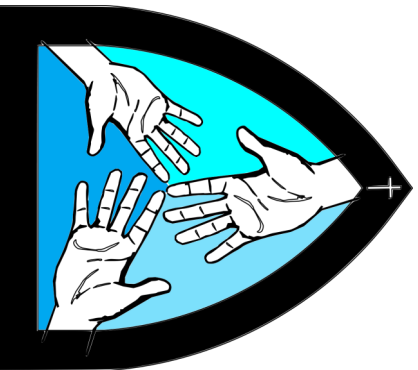
