Shared Ministry

Pastor Tracey Schultz, bishop's associate for the call process in the Gulf Coast Synod, met the St. Paul/St James congregations after a joint worship service on August 27. She outlined the process for the calling of our new pastor, inviting us to prayerfully remember that God's timing is of utmost concern in this time of transition.

One key element in this process is securing an interim pastor to provide continuing pastoral leadership. The Synod has no one to recommend at this time. I have agreed to be a supply pastor until an interim is found. That means I will be available to lead Sunday morning worship services and respond to pastoral needs.

The next step, either immediately or after an interim is in place is the formation of a call committee. As the councils move to form this committee, they will be looking for folks who prayerfully feel led to serve in this way - folks who are open-minded, discerning, confident in their ability to lead and willing to communicate with others, as appropriate, throughout the process.

In preparation for the calling of a pastor they will put together a Ministry Site Profile - a kind of resume for the congregation - seeking feedback from members of the congregation as they do so. That Profile is sent to the Synod and the search for candidates to interview begins.

Please continue to keep our congregations and their leaders in your prayers as we go through this transition together.
