
Shared Ministry Updates

Pastor Lawrence Bade met with both church councils on September 18. He suggested that even though there has not been an interim pastor assigned to our churches, we should move forward with gathering names for the Call Committee, It is recommend that four members from each congregation would compose the Call Committee. The goal is to have this Call Committee set up by the November council meeting.

As the councils move to form the Call Committee, they will be looking for folks who prayerfully feel led to serve in this way - folks who are open-minded, discerning, confident in their ability to lead and willing to communicate with others, as appropriate, throughout the process.

In preparation for the calling of a pastor they will put together a Ministry Site Profile - a kind of resume for the congregation - seeking feedback from members of the congregation as they do so. That Profile is sent to the Synod and the search for candidates to interview begins.

The transition process in the synod recommends that a practice interview helps prepare the call committee to effectively interview candidates. We should also be prepared to cover expenses for travel, hotel stays, etc once interviews begin.



October 29, 2023

Throughout the year we hear about many things in church-how we live our daily lives, the choices we make, the habits of our faith. On Reformation Sunday we are brought back to the most important thing – the thing that compelled Luther and others to risk their lives. We turn to the core of our faith: God loved us first, and God continues to shower us with grace and mercy. Reformation Sunday calls us to be more loving and grace-filled, because God was gracious and merciful to us. We are called to repent of the times that we have placed barriers that have kept others from hearing the Good News. We are called to remember that all that we are is a gift from God.

In the church in Wittenberg where Martin Luther preached, there is a painting showing Luther in the pulpit on the right hand side and the people on the left. In between people and the preacher is Christ on the cross. That is the bedrock of our faith – the grace and mercy given to us in Jesus Christ. Keeping the most important thing in the center of the picture is the only hope for our faith and for this community that we call "church."


