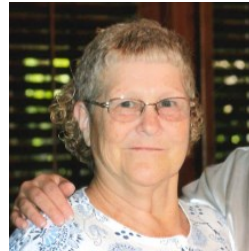

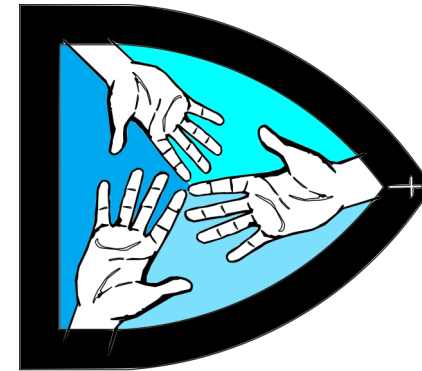

# Pastor's Column

## Giving Thanks for a Year Together

It is hard for my brain to believe that on August 1, 2018, I had my first interview with the shared call committee. By late September, it was a done deal and we were celebrating with a feast in the St James Family Life Center.

Some things haven't changed in a year—I'm still feeling so enthusiastic about ministry here, and I'm definitely still not used to sweating by 7:30am if outside—but other things have changed. It is a real gift to now know names and stories of the people and the histories of these churches. While there is certainly more learning still to come, that's the highlight of year 1 for me. What started as a few hundred strangers has transformed into known people who care about Jesus, care about the church, and care about discipleship.

There have been some "shared changes" too in this first year – moving to a shared newsletter, learning how to share a pastor in terms of time and events, and having our council leadership meeting together on the same night. Again, small steps, but important changes and adaptations. We cannot share ministry without at least knowing what is going on at our fellow church, and the cross-over attendance at worships and Lent and VBS is exciting to me.

In my own self, I sense my continued growth as I gain more "on-the-ground" experience here. In the first year out of school—and many of us have been here at some point or another in our lives—everything is a first. But those firsts become seconds and thirds, and things become familiar territory. Thank you all for answering so many of the "and how do we typically do this?" questions, and for your patience and willingness to adapt some, too.

Year 2 will bring its own adventures—some known (becoming a parent!), and some unknown. But after a year here, I trust that this community responds strongly together to do the joyful work of ministry. And, at the end of the day, we are servants of the true servant, and he will guide us along the way.

So, in words we will hear on August 18 in worship, "Since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith" (Hebrews 12)

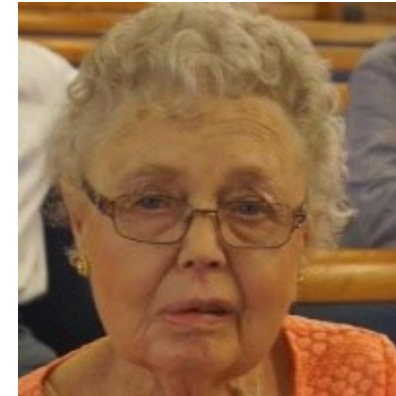

## NEW BETHEL CROSS

The new Bethel cross on our altar at St. James has been donated by Mary Ann and Joel Koonce in memory of her father, Pastor Herman Dannhaus. Pastor Dannhaus is one of two sons of the St. James congregation. He was born to Adolph and Theopelia Dannhaus in 1908. He was baptized and confirmed at St. James. He served several churches in and around San Antonio. Special thanks to the Koonces for the new cross!

German services were still being held in 1955 every fifth Sunday. In 1956 the wooden fences that surrounded the church were to be dismantled. Some items were taken care of in late 1956 and early 1957. A discussion was held on tearing down the parsonage and erecting a new one. The cost ran about \$4000 for materials, all labor would be voluntary. The new parsonage was dedicated on April 7, 1957. Also, the "outside toilets" were updated.

In 1958 it was voted to have a monthly newsletter sent to families. In 1960 Pastor Perry reported that ALC, ELC and UELC would combine to become the American Lutheran Church. Also in 1960 German services were stopped but people could still commune in the German language. Speaking of communion in 1961 there was only five communion services held through the year.

By 1962 the loan on the parsonage had been paid and the council felt the need to sell the adjoining pasture on the church grounds. Bids were accepted but all bids were unreasonable so the maintains the adjoining pasture. A discussion was also held in 1962 about putting toilets in the church. A bid was gotten to either place them in the back of the church or in the basement for \$1500.00. Still to this day, we have no toilets in the church.

In July of 1962, St. James renewed its lease of the Sunday School, which at one time was owned by the Austin County School District. It was renewed for 25 years for \$1. After the lease was renewed, the Sunday School had new petition walls put in and the building was re-roofed.
