Pastor's Column

Joy Endurance



One of the common assignments in our bible classes at seminary was a project called a "word study." This phrase brought out the same kind of groan elicited by the term "book report" in elementary school.

Here's the basic idea: the professor would assign each student one particular word in Greek from a bible passage, and it was our job to research the various roots of the word, how it could be translated in different ways, etc etc. I was an English major in college, so I always secretly liked these kinds of project, even though my Greek knowledge was and is extremely limited.

One of my final classes was a week-long intensive on the book of Romans, and for our word study, I was assigned the Greek verb for rejoice (*chairo*), from the famous and easy to remember verse of Romans 12:12—"Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer." I was surprised and delighted to learn that the noun "grace" (*charis*) comes from the very same root as rejoice. To know grace—to know the message of Easter resurrection—cannot be separated from rejoicing! There is a third English word that shares the same root of grace and rejoice, and it likely won't surprise you: charity (*chairiti*).

I imagine most of us think of rejoicing, grace, and charity as three separate things. One is a happy state of mind, one is a churchy word at the heart of Lutheran faith and theology, and one is how we describe acts of generosity. Yet how interesting it is to think about these words together – rejoicing often follows acts of charity...a giving heart comes naturally from experiencing God's grace....knowing grace brings joy!....Joy sparks the will to want to give generously...and the cycle continues.

I find these words remarkable as we continue to move through the Easter season. We gather with joy and laughter and singing as the church that exists in a world that is far from perfect. Yet our faith has a rich hope about it—not bland optimism, not a happygo-lucky vibe, but true "hope that does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit." (Romans 5:5)

May 2 | 5th Sunday of Easter Acts 8:26-40; Ps 22:25-31; 1 John 4:7-21; John 15:1-8 Christ the vine and we the branches are alive in each other. As the vine brings food to the branches, Christ feeds us at his table to bear fruit for the world.

May 9 | 6th Sunday of Easter Acts 10:44-48; Ps 98; 1 John 5:1-6; John 15:9-17 Christ shares the image of friendship. The Greeks believed that true friends are willing to die for each other.

May 16|7th Sunday of Easter Acts 1:15-17, 21-26; Ps 1; 1 John 5:9-13; John 17:6-19 Jesus' desire is that his followers will be one as he and the Father are one. This is the work of the Spirit.
