- 2. Open the app and click on the Create Login button.
- 3. Enter your email address that is used in your church's directory. Let us know if you aren't sure which email we have on file
- **4.** Create a password. The password must be 8 characters long and must contain at least two of the following special characters: capital letters, numbers or symbols.
- 5. Retype the password to confirm it and click Create Login.
- 6. Check your inbox for an email from service@instantchurchdirectory.com.
- 7. To complete the sign-up process, you will need to verify your email address by clicking on the link sent to you in that email.
- 8. Once you confirm your email, you may open the app and click Sign In to log into your church's directory using your email and new password.

Pastor's Column

Lent 2022: Resisting Indifference

"During Lent, let us find concrete ways to overcome **indifference**." – *Pope Francis*

""Repentance means turning toward other human beings, our own flesh and blood; it means acting with compassion instead of **indifference**." – *Sara Miles, Episcopalian* writer

"As Lent is the time for greater love, for listening to Jesus...'Repent and believe' Jesus tells us. What are we to repent? Our **indifference**, our hardness of heart." – *Mother Teresa*

Lent always arrives at a strange time. January and February tend to be quiet, colder, indoor months. And then, as warmer temperatures and longer sunlight comes back, we wade into Lent, with its solemn nature, dark purple décor, and a collection of worship readings that dig deep into the serious nature of discipleship. It is meant to be an intentional time to renew our faith – but, specifically, to be intentional about what?

This year, I've been thinking about intentionality vs indifference. As you can see in the famous quotes above, many faithful people consider indifference – not hate – to be the true opposite of faithful love. It is our apathy that can slowly deaden us inside.

Lent asks us to be intentional about certain habits, namely the big 4: prayer, acts of charity, fasting, and sacrifice. Acts of generosity for others, conversation with God, and giving up certain luxuries...these are not the actions of indifferent, apathetic people. They are acts of disciples, doing the little things to reawaken faith.

One more quote for this coming 40 day season – "Go and learn what this means – I desire mercy, not sacrifice." – Jesus. I pray for you to find acts of mercy this Lent, to stir you out of indifference and toward relationships of love and justice.
