Pastor's Column

Hanging Another Picture(s) on the Wall

It's been a hot minute since we confirmed any young adults at St Paul or St James.

Specifically—our last classes were in 2015 and 2017. It's nobody's fault that there's been a gap, just the effect of generational cycles and transition years.

When I had my second interview with the shared call committee, it included a tour of both churches (given by Lonnie T. and Wesley W. as I recall). I had never seen a church fellowship hall before with photographed histories of confirmands on the wall. It was especially fun to have various call committee members point out their photos from years past, educating me from the beginning that many family histories are deeply intertwined with each church.

I remember thinking at that moment, in fall 2018...*hey, if the next couple weeks go right, I might end up on here somewhere too.* And then came my second thought: *wow, a lot of these pastors look fairly intimidating and grumpy. I'm going to smile.*

Almost exactly 3 years later, we have 3 St James students and 5 St Paul students who will be confirmed this month. Additionally, in September, 9 students are beginning their "Bible" year starting the next wave. I've tried to instill in our students that confirmation is not the ending point in faith development. There's always more to learn, and for me, the real sparks of God getting my attention didn't come until high school mission trips. But it is a good foundation, where the simplicity of Sunday school gets complicated and built upon, where friendships can grow, and where hard questions can be chewed on together.

I hope you can join us to celebrate these young people claiming their faith, on 10/17 at St James, and 10/24 at St Paul.
