I am writing this to share with you about how a person's life can come full circle when a tragedy or a big disappointment occurs. Our family lived on my grandparents' (Theo. and Erna Winkelmann) farm. I had two younger brothers, Kenneth and Darrell, and 1 older brother, William.

I was six years old when my dad decided farming and ranching with my grandfather was no longer feasible to raise a family. We moved to Houston so that my dad could work with his cousin who was a homebuilder. I left behind memories of my grandparents such as my daily wagon rides by grandmother to go check the turkeys they raised. She sewed for me my own personal cotton sack so I could look like I was a real big helper and could look like my grandfather.

I attended the schools in the Spring Branch area of Houston. I made a lot of new friends but always looked forward to every other weekend trip back to New Wehdem and visiting with my grandparents. As the years went by, the trips to the farm and the visits with my grandparents grew less and less....

When Denominations Collide



Recently I had the true joy of traveling to the "Festival of Homiletics." Homiletics is the formal academic word for preaching (think cardiology = study of the heart). This festival is a collision of preachers from around the world (at least 10 other countries were represented) and from all different faith traditions. There were preachers from the formal, New England Congregationalist churches and preachers who walked with Dr. King and preach passionately on public streets more often than pulpits.

There were Lutherans, Evangelicals, Methodists, Presbyterians, Baptists, Catholics,

• Episcopalians, non-demonination folks, United Church of Christ folks, and everything in between. There were "holy rollers" and quiet poets. There were "hallelujahs!" and "aaaaaamen!" rained forward from those in the pews, and there were polite subtle head nods from others. We used different creeds, different Lord's Prayer translations, standard hymns and African spirituals.

It was a week to see just how different we worship across the Christian world....but it was also a week to see that we worship the same amazing God, and we tell the same life-altering story of God's son. Preachers may have different delivery styles, but all who preached worked to tell the same story about how the resurrection of Jesus changed everything. They spoke about how it gives us hope in the present. They spoke about how it challenges and defeats the evils and corruptions of the current world. They spoke about the serious task it is to follow this Risen One. They shared their imaginations of what God is up to in this world right now.

For me who often leads worship, it was a helpful perspective to sit in the pews for five days. I pray the experience will make me a better pastor, and I hope to try to carry some ideas experienced in Minnesota into our worships on occasion. Thank you for the opportunity to continue learning.

When you are young, you don't always see all the things going on around you, as you are too busy trying to occupy your time. It was the summer of 1969, and I was going to be a freshman in high school the next school year when my parents' divorce became a reality. For the next

couple of months, myself and my two younger brothers were being moved from here to there.

I remember that weekend when my Dad loaded us three brothers up in the car, and we were headed to New Wehdem to spend time with my grandparents. It was on that trip and that weekend that I remember my grandmother telling my Dad, "You need to leave the boys here with us – we will be fine."

The next six years living with my grandparents was life changing. They taught us everything you need to know in life by living their life as an example for us. I don't have enough space to share all the fond memories and life lessons of that time. As I grew older, I often looked back at all the sacrifices they made for me and for my two younger brothers. I often

wondered how my life would have turned out if not for the unfortunate occurrence. My grandparents were truly angels in my life, and they turned water into wine.





ST. JAMES 150TH ANNIVERSARY

Those present agreed that we want Pastor Evan to have the sermon. We will have adult and kids' choirs. Meal ideas will be presented by Nathan and Robert. Bobby will have special bookmarks printed. A new directory is in the works. A lot of work is being done to create a cemetery directory that will make it easier to locate graves. Gayle has spent many hours diagramming the cemetery. We also hope to clean some of the tombstones and place flowers on each grave for the celebration. A new sign in front of the church is being researched. Pam and James are researching the church history,

The next meeting will be at 9:30am on June 16. Everyone is invited to help.

From the Archives of St. James Lutheran Church by Knellen Quinteros

In February 1935 Pastor R. A. Schmidt was installed. During this year, a water leak in the church basement caused problems. This has been an ongoing battle since. Also in 1935 a gal-vanized pipe railing was added to the entrance steps. At the December meeting \$375 was paid on the church note leaving a balance of \$600. In 1937 another \$200 was paid.

Pastor Schmidt left the fall of 1937. At the congregational meeting of that year, it was made a custom the congregation will remain standing while the Pastor exits the church. In the middle of 1940 Pastor H. T. Flackmeier came. He asked for a sanitary toilet to be installed in the parsonage. Also in 1940 the minutes noted there would be 12 people coming forward to the chancel to be given communion. Also it was reported the Pastor shall receive a monthly income. Pastor Flackmeier in 1941 asked to join the Pension Plan. It was also in this year that "electric" lights were installed in the church.

During the next few years, a new fence was constructed around the cemetery. The American flag was added in the middle 40's to show patriotism for our "men in arms" during WW II. In 1944 a new envelope system was incorporated to collect money. In the fall of 1944 the church's Diamond Jubilee was held. Until next month
