
Shared Ministry Worship August 27 at St. James 10:00am

Pastor's Column

So Long, Farewell



I have a core belief when it comes to endings of things that are ministry related. It's relatively simple: in the church, we don't say goodbye. It's always a "see you later."

Why do I believe this? Why do I use this line at funerals? I can offer a few reasons. First, I've learned that the Lutheran world is a small enough place that we often run into old friends. That's the practical why.

But the main reasoning behind it is more spiritual. I do truly believe in what is called either the communion of the saints or the priesthood of all believers. In other words, I believe in a "life everlasting" environment where we have community again with all those we've know. The image isn't my original imagining—it's from Isaiah 25:

On this mountain the Lord of hosts will make for all peoples a feast of rich food, a feast of well-aged wines,

- 7 And God will destroy on this mountain the shroud that is cast over all peoples, the covering that is spread over all nations;
- 8 God will swallow up death forever.
 Then the Lord God will wipe away the tears from all faces

We say often in communion that we are having a "foretaste of the feast to come." This is the feast to come part of the equation.

In our time together these past 5 years, we have shared many feasts...potlucks, VBS meals, buffets in Galilee, quiet luncheons after a burial, and of course, breaking bread on Sunday morning. I will miss that fellowship from the deepest part of who I am. I will miss you, the people, the heart and soul of these congregations. But to the very grave, I also believe this is a see you later, because.....

I'll see you...one day...on the mountaintop.
